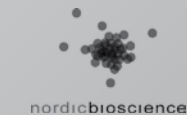

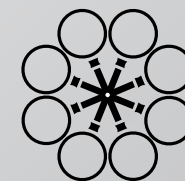

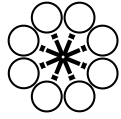

#### FACTS ABOUT THE SCHOOL

The Danish PhD School of Endocrinology is a new PhD school established on August 1, 2008. The school is financed by the University of Southern Denmark and Nordic Bioscience A/S.

#### Aims of the school

- To establish a world class, international PhD programme in clinical endocrinology.
- To build up a national and international network between leading researchers in the field of medical endocrinology.

#### MAIN FOCUS OF THE SCHOOL

The main focus of the school is application-oriented clinical endocrinology within the following disease areas.

- Calcium metabolic diseases
- Fibrosis
- Obesity
- Metabolic syndrome
- Diabetes mellitus

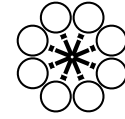
#### ENROLLMENT OF PHD STUDENTS

All scholarships are allocated to the Faculty of Health Sciences, University of Southern Denmark where the PhD students will be enrolled and employed. Employment will last for three years. All PhD students are required to produce at least 2 high impact publications.

#### PhD projects

Submission of relevant PhD projects can be forwarded to the school (see contact information). Accordingly, the project proposals will be evaluated by the school board. If the board accepts the project, the school will finance 2/3 of a scholarship, provided that the application for admission to the PhD programme is accepted by the Faculty of Health Sciences.

The total cost for 1/3 of a scholarship is approx. 300.000 DDK per year according to the PhD rates as of October 1st 2009 (the price will vary depending on what pay scale point the scholar starts at). A fully financed scholarship includes wage costs and operational costs PhD courses, travel expenses, central costs (including supervision, PhD courses, travel expenses, central costs etc.).

Industrial PhD projects are conducted in cooperation between a private business company, the Industrial PhD student and the Faculty of Health Sciences, University of Southern Denmark.
